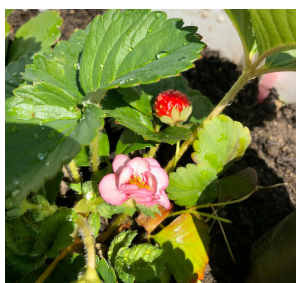
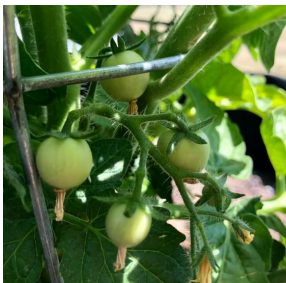
Neighborhood Garden Thrives!

Did You Know...



One of the historic homes in the StreetHeart Neighborhood was once home to a state legislator - **Burton Gordon Cameron** - who then became an attorney in Charlotte and was one of the organizers of the Charlotte Chamber of Commerce, as well as serving as president of the Eaton County Bar Association. His family lived at **129 Pleasant Street** in the 1950's and 60's in the home.

Attorney Cameron was a veteran of World War I and a member of the American Legion and the First Congregational Church in Charlotte. His son (also Burton Gordon Cameron) graduated from Charlotte High School and MSU, then graduated from West Point Academy Air Service. The Curran family has maintained the beauty of this home since the late 70's, where it continues as one of the highlights of the StreetHeart neighborhood.
