History Marker Project Application Deadline Extended

StreetHeart Block Leaders are working together to create a Neighborhood History Walk that encourages families to connect to our neighborhood in a new way. StreetHeart Block Leaders have offered to offset the cost with a \$35 grant for Neighbors who apply to obtain a new History Marker for their home.
