How Much Time Do You Need to be an Affordable Housing Landlord?

Being an affordable housing landlord requires almost no additional time! It only takes 10 minutes to sign up for most affordable housing program!



Working with affordable housing agencies can even save time since they can help you manage communications with your tenants and help you fill vacancies.

After this sign-up process, you are only responsible for 5 minutes of paperwork once a year to recertify your property. The affordable housing agency will let you know when it's time to recertify and submit an updated W9.
